

- 72 counties
- Divide into 5 regions
 - 8 primary offices around the state
- Central Office in Madison

- Bureaus & Regions
 - Bureaus statewide technical expertise
 - Regions project delivery & operations






Bureau of Structures



- 14,320 bridges in Wisconsin
 - 5,363 state-owned (38%)
 - 8,957 local-owned (62%)
- Most everything structures-related

- 87 total people
- Divide into 3 sections
 - Design, Development, and Maintenance





Bureau of Structures



Design Section

- 35 staff
- Bridge structural design, hydraulics, drafting, consultant design oversight, fabrication oversight, construction oversight, and...
- Almost all in our Central Office
- Fairly heavy consultant use design 30-40% in-house

Maintenance Section

- 38 staff
- <u>Inspection</u>, maintenance, repairs
- Spread throughout the state



Bureau of Structures



- Development Section
 - 13 staff
 - Structures asset management, data management, policy & standards, research, automation tools, and load rating
 - All in Central Office
 - 3 load rating staff + supervisor
 - Primary use of AASHTOWare is with BrR
 - Historically (and somewhat currently), a lot of in-house software
- Currently in the office 2 days a week, telecommuting 3 days








State Owned Bridges








- 42 movable bridges




Exhibit E- Map Showing Bridges with span exceeding 300 feet










St. Croix Crossing








- History of corrosion, repairs










NBI Condition Rating by # of Bridges State Owned


